

Workshop on ‘*Reinventing Extension System for Agricultural Transformation*’ organized

25th August, 2023, Bhubaneswar: A workshop on reinventing extension system for agricultural transformation was organized by Directorate of Extension Education, OUAT Bhubaneswar for KVKs of Odisha under the jurisdiction of ICAR-ATARI, Kolkata. At the outset, the Dean Extension Education, OUAT, Prof. P. Mishra while welcoming the Guest Speakers and participants highlighted the need of organizing such workshop to reorient the extension specialists make them capable to face the changing agricultural scenario of the nation. The Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. P.K. Roul inaugurated the programme and hoped that such type of workshops will certainly fulfil the generational gap in the changing paradigm of extension system. Dr. P. Das Ex- DDG(AE), ICAR spoke on the changes occurred in the agricultural extension system within the last century around the globe and the need of smart steps to be taken up for sustainable food production system.
