Hon'ble Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India Shri Radha Mohan Singh ji gave away the first Zonal Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Antyodhyay Krishi Puraskar 2016 for Zone XI to Shri A.Baburaj, an aqua farmer of Kozhikode district of Kerala. The award was presented on 25th September 2016, marking the birth centenary of Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyaya at a function organized at ICAR-Indian Institute of Spices Research, Kozhikode. Addressing the farmers on this occasion, Hon'ble Minsiter emphasized the need of recognizing the contribution of small and marginal farmers and the landless to agriculture and its allied sectors.



He lauded the efforts of Shri Babu Raj who has been practicing aqua farming for over two decades on his small farm under the technical guidance of ICAR-CMFRI, Kochi and ICAR-CIBA, Chennai.
